Globally acclaimed and the focus of a fast growing passionate fan-base of owners and drivers, Toyota's 86 coupe has been rewriting sports coupe history since its international launch with a string of Car of the Year and technology awards to its name.

The 86 evokes its inspiration, the iconic AE86 of the 1980s, with superbly balanced handling, free revving engine and a performance oriented rear wheel drive format.

Internationally, the top spec GT86 model was quickly out on the race track, winning its class in grueling endurance races at Spa and the Nurburgring.



FINDING NEW ZEALAND'S NEXT WORLD GHAMPION

The 86 was the subject of rapturous acclaim on debut. When it arrived in New Zealand it was named Car of the Year 2012. TOYOTA GAZOO Racing New Zealand picked up on the potential of the 86, producing a locally specified and professionally prepared race car, the TR 86. Built by TOYOTA GAZOO Racing New Zealand, the cars are designed for racing and can be certified for Targa road rallies and other competitions. But their primary purpose was clear from the outset.

Building on the globally recognised success of its unique Castrol Toyota Formnula Regional Oceania Championship, Toyota devised a closely controlled one-make championship for the TR 86, offering local race drivers the chance to be part of a close fought and exciting series that competes on New Zealand's leading race circuits.

The Toyota 86 Championship, like the Castrol Toyota Formnula Regional Oceania Championship, plays a role in helping rising race drivers hone their skills - and with the close grids of TR 86 competitors, it brings the added bonus of dedicated media coverage and television, helping to attract sponsors at driver and team level.

The Toyota 86 Championship celebrated its 10th year in 2023, an impressive milestone for a category which continues to grow its fields each season.

The championship has its own dedicated photographer, with images posted each evening of race weekends on the TOYOTA GAZOO Racing New Zealand Facebook page and the TGRNZ website. The images accompany professionally written media releases summarising the day's on-track activity.





TR-86

Proudly built at Hampton Downs by TOYOTA GAZOO Racing New Zealand, the TR 86 is purpose designed for the race track.

Carefully selected race specific components are added to the impressive standard specification to create a car at home on the circuit in the cut throat environment of a one make competition.

Each car features adjustable race shocks, race brake calipers and rotors, and Speedline 18-inch alloy wheels, fitted with Nexen tyres.

Inside, a colour Motec dash logs the car's performance data so drivers can identify areas of improvement

The driver's environment is all race car, with a Sparco touring car race seat, six point safety harness and race steering wheel all fitted inside an FIA six point roll cage.

Control parts ensure the championship remains competitive and fair. Only officially built TR 86 cars are eligible for the championship.

Motorsport Australia has recognised the high quality of driving in the New Zealand Toyota 86 Championship and its status in domestic Kiwi motorsport by awarding Supercars Superlicence points to the championship's top performers.

Thirteen points are required to qualify for a Motorsport Australia Superlicence and the winner of the Toyota 86 Championship will get a highly valuable five points towards that total. The championship runner up will receive four points, third place will receive three points, fourth place two points and the fifth place finisher one point.

It now means both TOYOTA GAZOO Racing New Zealand championships offer Supercars licence points with the winner of the Castrol Toyota Formula Regional Oceania Championship awarded ten points.

The links between the ultra-competitive NZ Toyota 86 Championship and the 'main game' series in Australia have been growing in recent seasons, with winners and top rookies appearing in one-off drives in the Australian TR86 series which supports the Supercars Championship at selected rounds and we have past NZ 86 drivers competing regularly in Super 2 and Super 3.

Our 2023 Toyota 86 Champion Brock Gilchrist was also awarded a Triple Eight Engineering Supercars test thanks to the Tony Quinn Foundation.

THE TONY QUINN FOUNDATION

The Tony Quinn Foundation has increased the amount of financial support it is giving New Zealand motorsport by reaffirming funding for various scholarships for a second year, and teasing a new initiative to help kiwi drivers launch an overseas career.

For the 2022-23 season the TQF has increased their commitment to CTFROC, Toyota 86 and Formula Ford along with a new initiative to help accelerate

Kiwi drivers in their initial offshore career progression.

Budding race car drivers who take part in the
Academy programmes at Quinn's Hampton Downs
facility are eligible for significant financial support
towards competing in the Toyota 86 Championship.

TQF has increased support for the Toyota programmes to over \$100,000. Of that, \$37,500 is

now available for the T86 Academy Shootout winner, who must be a rookie driver.

The major prize for the TR86 Championship in 2022 was a test drive in a V8 Supercar with Triple Eight Engineering, with inaugural winner Rowan Shepherd winning the prize-drive at Queensland Raceway. In 2023 Toyota 86 Championship Brock Gilchrist was awarded a Gen 3 Camaro test with Red Bull AMPOL Racing.


