## Assessment Day Core Criteria

It will be the responsibility of all selected candidates to arrange their own travel arrangements to and from the track and any costs that this may incur.

Applicants must also bring all their own race and fitness gear (trainers, shorts, t shirt) for the day. The cost for the day is \$1000 Incl GST payable on acceptance of entry.

### **FORMAT OF THE DAYS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:**

Welcome and introduction by Geoff Short – TOYOTA GAZOO Racing New Zealand

- Driver briefing
- Fitness assessment
- On-track driving assessment - 2 x 15mins
- Media interview
- Interview with Geoff Short
- Successful applicant announced end of day

Each specific area of assessment on the day will be scored out of a possible maximum 50 points.

As a driver progresses through the programme, they will accumulate points and the driver with the highest score at the end of the day will be awarded the scholarship.

Please note that lunch and refreshments will be provided on the day.
